



Health Warranty and Purchase Agreement

This contract is between April Cliber (hereafter "Seller") and _____ (hereafter "Buyer") and is entered on this date _____.

Seller's Responsibility:

1. The Seller guarantees the puppy is in good health, is up-to-date on immunizations appropriate for the puppy's age and has been dewormed, at the time the Buyer takes possession. The Buyer has five business days to take the puppy to a veterinarian for an examination. If the puppy is found to be in poor health, the Buyer has 2 options: (1) return the puppy to the Seller at Buyer's expense and receive a refund of the purchase price or (2) keep the puppy and the Seller will reimburse all veterinary costs, up to the purchase price, related to the treatment of any pre-existing condition.
2. This warranty, excluding item #1 above, is valid for twenty six (26) months after the birth of the puppy (date is noted as "Born on").
3. This warranty includes hip dysplasia, elbow dysplasia, eye conditions that are genetic in origin, von Willbrand's Disease, and genetic heart disorders that are serious enough to require treatment. In the event the puppy exhibits symptoms of one of these defects, the Buyer must contact the Seller immediately and supply any and all requested veterinary records to the Seller.
4. If it is determined the puppy has a genetic disorder listed in #3 above, the Buyer has 2 options: (1) reimbursement of all veterinary expenses related to the illness up to the purchase price of the puppy - excluding shipping or (2) choose a replacement puppy from the next available litter. If a replacement puppy is chosen, your current puppy need not be returned to us. If the replacement puppy requires shipping, those fees are to be paid by the Buyer.
5. If the puppy should die from a suspected genetic disorder listed in #3 above, an autopsy must be performed at the Buyer's expense by a veterinary teaching hospital or state licensed DVM acceptable to the Seller's own veterinarian. If the autopsy shows a genetic disorder listed in #3 above as the reason for the death, the Seller will provide another puppy of equal value to the Buyer. A written statement from the veterinarian must be provided. This warranty is void in the event of an indeterminable or inconclusive diagnosis.
6. This warranty does not include viral illnesses, infections, improper bites, hernias, hypoglycemia, Guardia or Coccidiosis. It also does not include any illness due to the ingestion of foreign objects, food, chemicals, physical injury, or issues whose cause is unknown or may have an environmental link.
7. Seller agrees to provide the number of the microchip that has been implanted in the puppy.
8. This warranty is non-transferable.

Buyer's Responsibility:

1. The Buyer agrees to pay the Seller a total sum of \$ _____. This fee does not include shipping, if shipping is required.
2. Buyer understands that because this is a crossbreed (not a "standardized breed"), Seller cannot guarantee the puppy to be hypoallergenic or low shedding. Furthermore, Seller cannot guarantee the size, weight, or coat types once puppy is fully grown.
3. The Buyer agrees that their Doodle will be housed indoors.
4. The Buyer agrees to feed their Doodle only a quality food.
5. The Buyer agrees to keep their Doodle at a healthy weight.
6. The Buyer agrees to make and keep annual veterinary appointments for their Doodle and keep all immunizations current according to the guidelines of the AVMA and properly administer heartworm preventative.
7. The Buyer agrees to provide basic obedience training with their Doodle within the first year of owning their dog.
8. The Buyer agrees to postpone strenuous, repetitive exercise (such as agility class and running miles a day) until after their Doodle is over one year of age.
9. The Buyer agrees to contact the Seller immediately if the Buyer determines they are unable to keep their Doodle for any reason. The Buyer and Seller will determine how the dog will be re-homed.
10. The Buyer agrees to never place the Doodle in a shelter, pound, or similar facility or research laboratory.
11. The Buyer understands that the money paid for the puppy is non-refundable unless the puppy is found to have a debilitating genetic defect as stated in this contract.
